

MAC (Apple) Mail

Step 1:	Open Mac Mail by clicking the Icon
Step 2:	Go to the Mac 'Mail' menu and click 'Preferences'
Step 3:	Click on the Mac Mail account you wish to edit – It should be your RCN account Click on the 'Outgoing Mail Server' drop down menu and select 'Edit SMTP Server List...'
Step 4:	Go to the 'Advanced' tab Uncheck 'Automatically detect and maintain account settings' Set the port to '25' (or 587 for SSL encryption) Click on 'Authentication' Enter your RCN username and password IMPORTANT: If your email address is abc123@rcn.com , then your username is 'abc123' Click 'OK'
Step 5:	You have now setup the [RCN] outgoing mail server Please ensure that '[RCN]' is selected in the drop-down menu next to 'Outgoing Mail Server' Close the window
Step 6:	When prompted click 'Save' to keep the changes
Step 7:	When you first click 'Get Mail' or go to send an email you may need to re-enter your [RCN] password We recommend that you save the password in your keychain
Step 8:	If you would like to use your [RCN] service with multiple accounts you just need to click on the account you wish to edit, click on the 'Outgoing Mail Server' drop down menu and then select '[RCN]' from the list of servers. All Done!
